

## Snapshot: Victorian community perceptions of corruption survey 2022





Most Victorians have heard about IBAC, but few have a good understanding




Most Victorians agree that they know what behaviour constitutes corruption



Two thirds of Victorians agree that corruption is a problem in Victoria

The police behaviours most likely to be identified as **definitely corrupt** are







29% strongly agree

47% somewhat agree

76%



Most Victorians agree that 'if I personally observed corruption or misconduct,

I would definitely report it'

54% would report serious corruption and misconduct to IBAC

6% strongly agree

27% somewhat agree

33%



One third of Victorians agree that 'if I reported corruption, I would experience personal repercussions'

4% strongly agree

33% somewhat agree

37%



Over one third of Victorians agree that **'if I reported corruption, meaningful action** would be taken'; most have no formed opinion (37% 'neither agree nor disagree', 15% 'don't know')
