

Independent Broad-based Anti-Corruption Commission Act 2011

SUPPRESSION ORDER

A PERSON KNOWINGLY ENGAGING IN CONDUCT THAT CONSTITUTES A CONTRAVENTION OF THIS SUPPRESSION ORDER COMMITS AN OFFENCE. PENALTIES INCLUDING IMPRISONMENT APPLY.

In accordance with section 129A(1) of the **Independent Broad-based Anti-Corruption Commission Act 2011**, IBAC:

ORDERS THAT:

1. Except with the express written permission of the IBAC, publication of any information or evidence relating to any person's contact details, including residential and business addresses, telephone numbers and email addresses, referred to during these public examinations, is prohibited.

APPLICABLE GROUNDS:

- To prevent prejudice or hardship being caused to any person.

EXPIRATION DATE: Until further order.

For the purpose of this order, publication means the dissemination or provision of access to the public by any means including:

- online, in a book, newspaper, magazine or other written publication;
- broadcast on radio or television;
- public exhibition; or
- any other broadcast or electronic communication.
