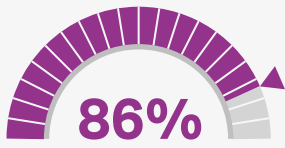
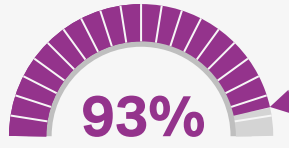




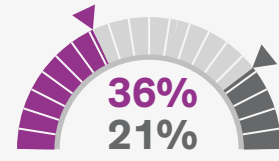
# Victorian business suppliers perceptions of corruption survey 2022

Most suppliers agree that they know what behaviour constitutes corruption



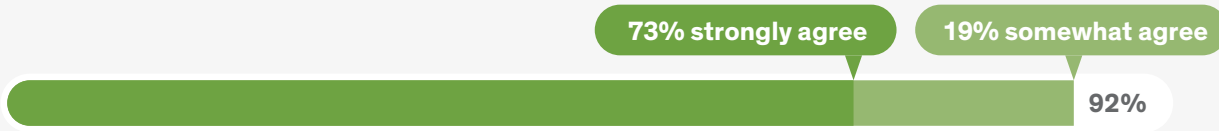
More than a third of suppliers **agree** that 'if I reported corruption to IBAC, I am confident that my report would be handled appropriately'. One in five suppliers **disagree**



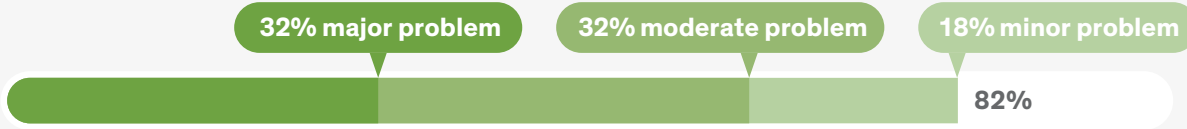

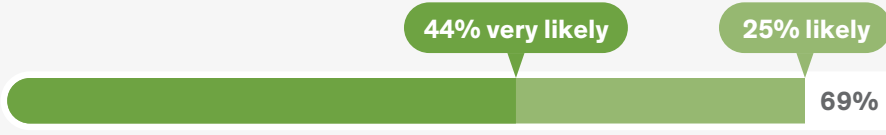
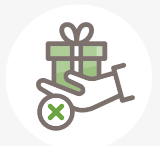
Favouritism is the behaviour most considered to be a **high risk** of occurring, particularly related to procurement



Almost all suppliers agree it is **important that IBAC exists**



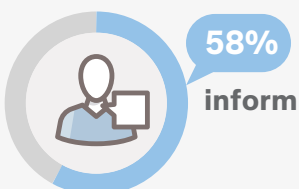
Most suppliers consider **corruption in public sector procurement to be a problem**



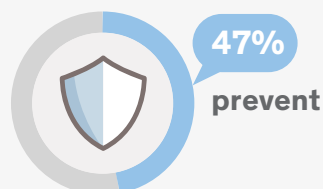
Most suppliers claim they would be very likely or likely to **report serious corruption in procurement**



The majority of suppliers are at least somewhat confident in IBAC's ability to:



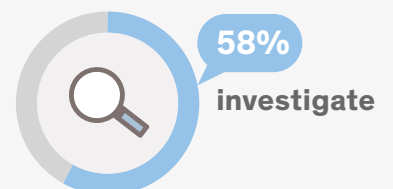
