

Victorian business suppliers perceptions of corruption survey 2022





Most suppliers have heard about IBAC



Most suppliers agree that they know what behaviour constitutes corruption



More than a third of suppliers agree that 'if I reported corruption to IBAC, I am confident that my report would be handled appropriately'. One in five suppliers disagree



Favouritism is the behaviour most considered to be a high risk of occurring, particularly related to procurement
